The peak vegetable season runs during winter and includes beetroot, pumpkin, carrots, lettuce and broccoli, but other products are available year round. Look out for some of these crops at our many roadside stalls located throughout the region.

Avocados: January, March – December

Beetroot: June – November

Broccoli and Cauliflower: April – October

Carrots: June – December

Corn: mid November – mid May

Green Beans: November, December,
March – May

Lettuce: April – September

Olives: Harvested in April and late March.
Flower late September, early October.

Onions: January – September

Potatoes: June – July, November

Pumpkin: May – July, November – March

Rhubarb: Available year round

Tamarillos (tree tomatoes): Available on
Tamborine Mountain February – August

Zucchini: December – April



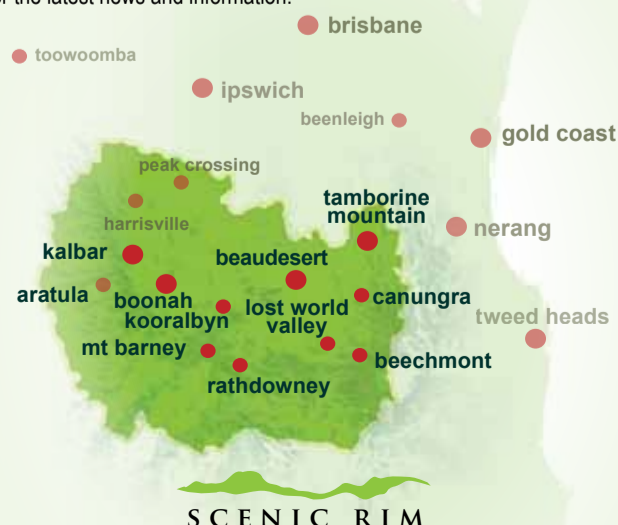
