

Monumental Work Styles (Boonah and Kalbar Cemeteries)

Full design and structural details are to be submitted with the application to allow for assessment.

- A grave must have time to settle, therefore a plaque or monument cannot be placed on the gravesite (where there is no concrete beam) until at least 6 months have passed since interment.
- Grave numbers are to be embossed on all plaques and monuments.

Lawn and Semi-Lawn Section Plaques

- Lawn Plaques are to be placed on a standard concrete base (530mm x 380mm with or without vase/s) (available for purchase from Council).
- All plaques (including bases) are to be a minimum thickness of 100mm.
- The upper surface of the plaque is to be above or at ground level.
- Semi-Lawn Plaques are to be placed on standard concrete desk supplied by Council or similarly sized stone desk.

Monumental Section Memorials

- Other monuments which are soundly constructed of stone or concrete with a solid edge not less than 100mm above ground level and up to the full size of the plot.
- All monuments must comply with AS 4204-1994.
