### FREE RECYCLING

Steel, metals, vehicle batteries, oil (<25ltr), DrumMuster (plastic drums), E-waste, paint, paper/ cardboard, glass, hard plastics, mobile phones, toner cartridges. Not all recycling is available at all sites. Please see website or call Council on 5540 5111 to check recycling for each transfer station.

### NOTE

- Receipt of all waste is subject to both Council and Dept. of Environment & Science acceptance criteria and licence conditions.
- No commercial loads of waste more than 2 cubic metres or tree stumps will be accepted at Council's Waste Transfer Stations. These items must be taken to Central Landfill.
- Charges at Central Landfill are by the tonne, however, Council reserves the right to charge by the cubic metre for large bulky items of little weight e.g. foam, polystyrene, wool, clothing.
- Council reserves the right to refuse to accept waste at any of its facilities, or direct waste to be taken to a designated facility, or to request that recyclable materials are separated from general waste or to request that the waste is presented in an acceptable manner for disposal e.g. bagged or wrapped.
- Special Burial includes, but is not limited to: asbestos, regulated waste, large dead animals, etc. Special Burial can only be undertaken at Central Landfill. Acceptance and charges will be assessed on a case by case basis. Small dead animals may be disposed of at Central landfill as general waste if they are sealed in double-wrapped, strong plastic bags.
- Fees must be paid prior to the disposing of any waste.
- A receipt will be issued for all transactions requiring payment.
- It is a condition of entry to Council's waste facilities that users will abide by the above criteria and obey all directions of Council's waste facility staff.
- Domestic customers means SRRC residents obtaining mulch for use at their own home.
- Tip Master to decide on the type of waste load based on legislation and guidelines.
- Co-mingled recycling disposal in commercial quantities should be pre-arranged with Council prior to disposal. Charges will be discretionary and determined in accordance with disposal locations.
- SRRC residents are those that reside within Councils designated region and can show proof of residency at the transfer station. Without proof of residency all charges will be as per commercial and non-resident charges.

## What is 1m<sup>3</sup>?

A cubic metre is 1 metre x 1 metre x 1 metre OR about the size of an average domestic trailer OR what four 240L wheelie bins can hold. Residents of the region are permitted to dispose the first 1m<sup>3</sup> of general waste for free.

## What is a domestic trailer and what is a hire trailer?

The average domestic (or box) trailer carries about 1m<sup>3</sup> (about 1.8m x 1.2m x 0.5m). A hire trailer is any trailer larger than an average domestic trailer.

## What is General Waste from households?

This is waste from household activities including waste from the kitchen and bathroom, clean up/renovation waste such as carpet, furniture, mattresses, appliances, plaster board, tiles, and other waste items that are not identified separately in Council's disposal charges.



## Refrigeration Units

Include but are not limited to: Vehicles which have intact air conditioner systems, self contained household air conditioners, refrigerators and freezers. The charge applies to check and degas the units in accordance with environmental legislation.

## Loading of Mulch

Mulch loads must be covered or restrained prior to leaving the waste facility. Council may refuse to load trailers with inadequate cover. Littering on roads is an offence.

For large quantities of mulch, please phone Council prior to collection on 5540 5111.



## Special Burials

Accepted with Council approval and prior arrangement only. This includes asbestos products, dead animals and other types of waste that may require special burial at the landfill.

### SITE RULES FOR EVERYONE'S SAFETY

To ensure everyone's health and safety, Council reminds you of the general rules that apply when you use our waste facilities:

- Follow directions of site staff at all times including requests for inspection of loads.
- Obey all signs including speed limits and be alert for other vehicles and pedestrians on site.
- Always wear covered footwear.
- No smoking on-site.
- Children under 16 and animals should remain inside vehicles at all times.
- Cover or restrain all loads while traveling to and from the facility.
- Do not scavenge from the site, including from waste bins, tip face or scrap metal piles.

### SEPARATE AND SAVE

Council encourages householders to separate recyclable items from their general waste for recycling. Look at Council's website [www.scenicrim.qld.gov.au](http://www.scenicrim.qld.gov.au) or call 5540 5111 for more information on what can be recycled at your local waste facility. The more you separate your recyclables, the lower waste disposal fee you pay! Most recyclables are free.



## What is Green Waste?

This includes:

- grass cuttings and garden clippings
- bushes, shrubs
- tree branches, stumps, trunks or root balls (less than 40cm diameter)
- timber (please consult on-site staff about timber with nails, bolts or plastic coating such as laminate)

### HINT:

Please separate your green waste items from other wastes so they can be stockpiled separately and mulched. Mulch is available free for residents who load the mulch into their trailer or ute themselves.

## Tree Stumps

Tree branches, stumps, trunks or tree root balls greater than 40cm diameter will only be accepted for disposal at Central Landfill. These need to be placed separately to the green waste. Please see the weighbridge officer.
