

# Plumbing Permit Work

## Request for Extension of Time and/or to Amend a Permit

Commencing 1 July 2019, the new Plumbing and Drainage Act 2018 (PDA 2018) and Plumbing and Drainage Regulation 2019 (PDR 2019) came into effect.

## Duration of a Permit

Commencing 1 July 2019, the plumbing permit takes effect the day the permit is issued and the permit ends two years from this date.

If Scenic Rim Regional Council (SRRC) has issued a permit and has not given a final inspection certificate for work carried out under the permit, at least 3 months before the permit is to end, SRRC must give notice of the day the permit is to end to:-

- The permit holder; and
- If the permit holder is not the owner of the premises to which the permit relates - the owner of the premises.

## Applying to SRRC for an Extension of Time and/or to Amend a Permit

An eligible person (permit holder or owner) may apply under s43 of the PDR 2019 to SRRC to extend the term of the permit no more than two years or to apply for an amendment to the permit.

An application must be submitted on the approved Form 2 and be accompanied by SRRC application fee. Refer to Scenic Rim Regional Council

In some cases, additional information and/or documentation may be required.

An application must be made and submitted to Council at least 10 business days before the permit ends.
