We currently have **two** exciting opportunities for suitably skilled and experienced Bridge Carpenters to join our Resources and Sustainability team on a permanent, full-time basis. *This role will require the successful applicants to work from any of Council's depots depending on operational requirements.*

As the Bridge Carpenter, you will be required to carry out technical work related to construction and maintenance of concrete and timber bridges, associated drainage structures and civil works.

Other key responsibilities of this role include the following:

- Support and assist with the development of staff and uphold work standards.
- Ensure complete and accurate records are captured, created and maintained within the appropriate recordkeeping system in accordance with Council policies and procedures.
- Exercise skills in human relations to ensure harmony with other Council Departments, other Government and Statutory Organisations, and the general public.
- Review and evaluate procedures and techniques utilised by the team to determine and improve efficiently and effectiveness.
- Assume responsibility for security and condition of Council vehicles and equipment utilised, including storage of small plant and tools in secured lockable containers provided by Council.
- Fulfil the obligations of a worker for safety in the project in accordance with the Workplace Health and Safety Act 2011

The successful applicants will have:

- Certificate of Competency as a Carpenter (desirable) or equivalent experience.
- Certificate III in Civil Works (desirable).
- Current HR Class License.
- Construction Induction Card.
- Minimum 3 years' experience in civil construction or maintenance.
- Prior experience in concreting desirable, particularly relating to bridges or other structures.
- Knowledge of relevant regulations and Council policies.

Conditions of employment for this full-time position will be in accordance with Council's Enterprise Bargaining Agreement and relevant Award with the remuneration being \$57,388.72 per annum (38-hour week).
