7.1 Amendment to the 2017 2018 Register of Fees and Charges

Executive Summary

The purpose of this report is to request Council's approval to amend the 2017/2018 Register of Fees and Charges, effective immediately.

Previous Council Considerations / Resolutions

Special Meeting 15 June 2017 Item 1.6 Council resolved that Council adopt the 2017/2018 Register of Fees and Charges in accordance with sections 97(1) and 262(3)(c) of the *Local Government Act 2009.*

Finance Committee Meeting 23 October 2017 Item No 2.1, Council resolved to consider this item at the Ordinary Meeting 30 October 2017.

REPORT

Council is required to maintain a Register of Fees and Charges under the Local Government Act 2009. Since the last update of the Fees and Charges, a request has been received to amend the Register as follows:

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New fee to be added:

Application for Tree Removal AssessmentPrice on ApplicationTree RemovalPrice on Application

The fee associated with a tree removal application will be based on the actual cost of removal of part or all of the tree /trees identified for remediation works, plus nominal admin costs to assess and process the application.
