Lake Moogerah Caravan Park Upgrade Works

Stage 2: October 2021 to August 2022

Scenic Rim Regional Council continues to upgrade the Lake Moogerah Caravan Park as part of our ongoing commitment to provide modern and accessible facilities for the enjoyment of residents and visitors to the Scenic Rim.

Lake Moogerah Caravan Park is a Council controlled camping ground on Muller Park Road, managed by Belgravia Pro, with 115 camping sites (including a limited number of powered caravan sites).

The park remains open for campers, caravanners, cabins and day trippers throughout construction.

This staged project of works will future-proof the facilities for planned expansions of camping sites by upgrading aged electrical, water and effluent systems, and will deliver potable water throughout the park, accessible and modern toilet and shower facilities, and a new camp kitchen with appliances including fridges and microwaves.

Stage 1 works are complete, with the installation of a water treatment plant, upgrade of the effluent storage system and installation of the associated tanks.

Continued Stage 2 works currently in construction involve:

- Electrical network upgrades including a new main switchboard and the replacement of overhead powerlines with underground reticulation,
- Commissioning of the newly installed water treatment and effluent systems with trenching works and installation of pipes throughout the facility,
- Demolition of an existing and construction of new main amenities building,
- · Construction of a new camp kitchen facility, and
- Associated retaining wall construction and landscaping.

WHEN IS THIS HAPPENING?

Stage 2 works are underway and expected to be completed by August, weather and construction conditions permitting. Works are continuing to progress despite weather impacts which has also increased the water level of the dam.

Works will generally occur between 7.00am to 6.00pm Monday to Saturday.

WHERE IS IT HAPPENING?

Trenching works will happen in various locations throughout the facility. Demolition and construction works will be located at and around the current amenities.

WHAT CAN I EXPECT?

The park will remain open and advance notification will be provided for any expected disruptions. We request locals and visitors take extra care when on-site and adhere to all signage and temporary access restrictions.

Council acknowledges there may be a level of inconvenience to park users while these works are being undertaken. Your patience and understanding is appreciated during this time.

At times there will be earthworks machinery entering the campground and camp users may hear some construction noise during the day. Access to areas of the park will be restricted for short periods whilst trenching works take place. There will be intermittent power outages, at those times cabin and caravan occupiers will be reminded to remove perishables from fridges and freezers.
