

# School Road, Tamborine Mountain

June 2022

## Footpath Reconstruction

Council will reconstruct a 166 metre section of footpath along School Road at Tamborine Mountain as part of Council ongoing commitment to deliver an accessible and serviced region. The works will improve pedestrian and cyclist safety along School Road.

### When will it happen?

Works are scheduled to commence in late June and are expected to take up to three weeks to complete, weather and construction conditions permitting. Works will generally occur between 6.30am to 6.00pm Monday to Saturday.

### Where will it happen?

Works will occur from the car park at Saint Bernard State School towards Siganto Street. Works will replace the current footpath with a new concrete footpath.

### What can I expect?

From time to time, there may be minor traffic delays along School Road to allow construction traffic to access work areas.

Every effort has been made to keep disruption to a minimum to reduce the impact on the travelling public.

Council acknowledges there may be a level of inconvenience to business owners, pedestrians and motorists while these works are being undertaken. Your patience and understanding is appreciated during this time whilst these works are undertaken.
