Jervis Place to Beechmont State School

Footpath Construction

Council will construct a new 1.18km footpath along Jervis Place, from Windabout Road to the front of the Beechmont State School as part of its ongoing commitment to deliver an accessible and serviced region to improve pedestrian and cyclist safety.

When will it happen?

Works are scheduled to commence in mid to late July 2022 and are expected to take approximately 4-5 weeks to complete, weather and construction conditions permitting. Works will generally occur between 6.30am to 6.00pm Monday to Saturday.

Where will it happen?

Works will occur from the intersection of Windabout Road and Jervis Place and continue through to the front of the Beechmont State School and will involve a new concrete footpath.

What can I expect?

From time to time, there may be minor traffic delays on Jervis Place and Beechmont Road to allow construction traffic to access work areas.

Every effort has been made to keep disruption to a minimum to reduce the impact on the travelling public.

Council acknowledges there may be a level of inconvenience to business owners, pedestrians and motorists while these works are being undertaken. Your patience and understanding is appreciated during this time whilst these works are undertaken.
