Garden Bed and Drainage Works

Council will construct a curved garden bed and planting at Staffsmith Park behind the newly constructed amenities block, as well as additional drainage works. This forms part of Council's ongoing commitment to deliver parks and playgrounds that provide places for recreation, relaxation and community connection. The works will improve the visual amenity of drainage within the new facility.

When will it happen?

Works are scheduled to commence in late July and are expected to take up to three weeks to complete, weather and construction conditions permitting. Works will generally occur between 6.30am to 6.00pm Monday to Saturday.

Where will it happen?

Works will occur behind the amenities block at Staffsmith Park, off Central Avenue, Mount Tamborine.

What can I expect?

There will be earthworks machinery and general construction vehicles in and around the park. Some areas will be fenced off with signs in place and construction noise will be heard throughout the day. We request locals and visitors take extra care when on-site and adhere to all signage and temporary access restrictions.

Every effort has been made to keep disruption to a minimum. The amenities block and park facilities will remain open during construction.

Council acknowledges there may be a level of inconvenience to park users while these works are being undertaken. Your patience and understanding is appreciated during this time.
