- Manage Council's master key system, access controls and alarm codes at Council facilities and sites, including maintaining key registers and updating Council's master key plans.
- Manage the installation, maintenance and testing of Council's fire systems in accordance with relevant legislation, including monitoring fire detection systems and fire equipment.
- Manage the installation, operation, maintenance and regular testing of Council's defibrillators, duress and emergency door lock buttons.
