

Teviotville Road, Kalbar

Road restoration works

Council is continuing to undertake restoration works on wide-spread sections of various sealed and unsealed roads across the Scenic Rim region.

These restoration works are being delivered with assistance provided through the jointly-funded Commonwealth-State Disaster Recovery Funding Arrangements (DRFA) following previously declared disaster events, those being:

- South East Queensland Coastal Trough, 12 - 15 December 2020;
- Southern Queensland Severe Weather, 20 - 31 March 2021;
- Central, Southern and Western Queensland Rainfall and Flooding, 10 Nov - 3 Dec 2021;
- South East Queensland Rainfall and Flooding, 22 February - 5 April 2022; and
- Southern Queensland Flooding, 6 - 20 May 2022.

These restoration works will improve road conditions for motorists and return damaged road surfaces to their pre-disaster condition.

These works will also ensure the Scenic Rim has a well-maintained, safe and interconnected transport network and are part of Council's commitment to providing an accessible and serviced region, and to maintaining and improving the region's civil infrastructure.

Teviotville Road, Kalbar

With assistance of funding administered by the Queensland Reconstruction Authority (QRA) on behalf of the Australian and Queensland Governments under DRFA, Teviotville Road at Kalbar has been prioritised for major restoration works based on the extent of damage and will include:

- Road pavement reconstruction, including seal; and
- Drainage reinstatement works.

WHEN WILL IT HAPPEN?

Minor works at Teviotville Road are scheduled to commence in late August 2022, followed by full reconstruction works upon assessment from QRA. Restoration works are expected to take up to 5 months to complete, weather and construction conditions permitting. Planned hours of work are between 6.00am and 6.00pm, Monday to Friday, however may include Saturday works when particular activities require.

WHERE WILL IT HAPPEN?

Works will occur on Teviotville Road at Kalbar, from Edward Street to the intersection of Hoya Road near Kalbar.

WHAT CAN I EXPECT?

Teviotville Road will remain open under traffic control during these restoration works, however there will be changed traffic conditions with delays of up to 15 minutes.

Motorists and pedestrians are requested to observe traffic advisory signage and directions from authorised traffic controllers to 'stop, hold and go'.

Construction plant will be active in the area during project construction, and there will be noise and vibration at the site, as well as dust. Every effort has been made to keep disruption to a minimum to reduce the impact on the travelling public.

Council acknowledges there may be a level of inconvenience to business owners, pedestrians and motorists while these works are being undertaken. Your patience and understanding is appreciated.
