

Church Street, Boonah

Minor works

Council has engaged a specialist contractor to repair potholed and uneven road pavement at Church Street in Boonah.

These works will improve road conditions for motorists and are delivered under Council's 2022 - 2023 Capital Works Program.

Repair works are being undertaken as part of Council's commitment to providing an accessible and serviced region, and to maintaining and improving the region's civil infrastructure.

WHEN WILL IT HAPPEN?

Night works are scheduled to commence on Sunday 11 September 2022 between 7.00pm and 5.00am, weather and construction conditions permitting.

WHERE WILL IT HAPPEN?

Works will occur at the roundabout in Church Street at Boonah, extending into part of High Street.

WHAT CAN I EXPECT?

Church Street will remain open under traffic control during these restoration works, however there will be changed traffic conditions with some minor delays of up to 15 minutes.

Motorists and pedestrians are requested to observe traffic advisory signage and directions from on-site traffic control.

Every effort has been made to keep disruption to a minimum to reduce the impact on the travelling public.

Council acknowledges there may be a level of inconvenience to business owners, pedestrians and motorists while these works are being undertaken. Your patience and understanding is appreciated during this time whilst these works are undertaken.
