RELATED CONDITIONS

1. The pipeline on the road reserve is to have a minimum cover of 600mm below natural surface.
2. The pipes shall be placed in position and in a manner approved by the Manager Technical Services, and shall be maintained to the satisfaction of the Manager Technical Services.
3. The work shall proceed without any interruption to traffic and any step necessary for the protection of the public during construction shall be taken by the owner.
4. The owner will be required to remove or protect the pipes at his own expense during any rebuilding or maintenance operations on or along the road.
5. Prior to commencement of the work the applicant or owner shall identify any existing services (Energex, Telstra etc.) and shall carry out the work so as to prevent any damage to such services.
6. The owner will be required to repair or cause to be repaired at his expense any damage to the roadway due to the existence of the pipes.
7. The pipeline for its full length is to be marked at a maximum of 200m intervals, or at bends, junctions or the like, with water pipeline markers, which can be purchased from Council's Works Coordinator's Office.
8. Maintenance of pipe markers shall be the responsibility of the owner for the life of the pipeline.
9. The owner, by accepting the above conditions hereby indemnifies the Scenic Rim Regional Council against any claim, action or process for damage or injury which might arise during the progress of the work and shall keep indemnified the Scenic Rim Regional Council against any claim, action or process for damage and/or injury which might arise from the existence of the pipes.
10. This authority may be withdrawn by the Scenic Rim Regional Council at any time by giving thirty (30) days' notice in writing and if so required by the Scenic Rim Regional Council, the owner shall remove the pipes at his own expense. If the owner fails to remove the pipes within the time specified, the Scenic Rim Regional Council may cause the pipes to be removed and recover the cost from the owner.
