

The Stan Martin Bridge, Oaky Creek Road, Oaky Creek

October - November 2022

Bridge Maintenance Works

Council will carry out component replacement works at The Stan Martin Bridge, Oaky Creek Road, Oaky Creek. This will include replacement of some of the timber piles and headstocks.

The Stan Martin Bridge will be temporarily closed for these works to occur.

WHEN WILL IT HAPPEN?

Works are scheduled to commence 27 October 2022, and is expected to take up to 4 weeks to complete, weather and construction conditions permitting. Works will generally occur between 6.30am to 6.00pm Monday to Saturday.

WHERE WILL IT HAPPEN?

Works will occur at the Oaky Creek crossing along Oaky Creek Road at Oaky Creek.

WHAT CAN I EXPECT?

To facilitate rehabilitation works, a temporary road closure of Oaky Creek Road at Oaky Creek will be required for the duration of these works.

Alternative routes will be in place via Oaky Creek Road, Oaky Connection Road and Oaky Scrub Road. Detour signs will be erected prior to works.

Construction plant will be active in the area during project construction, and there will be noise and vibration at the bridge site.

Council acknowledges there may be a level of inconvenience to business owners, residents, pedestrians and motorists while these works are being undertaken. Your patience and understanding is appreciated during this time whilst these works are undertaken.

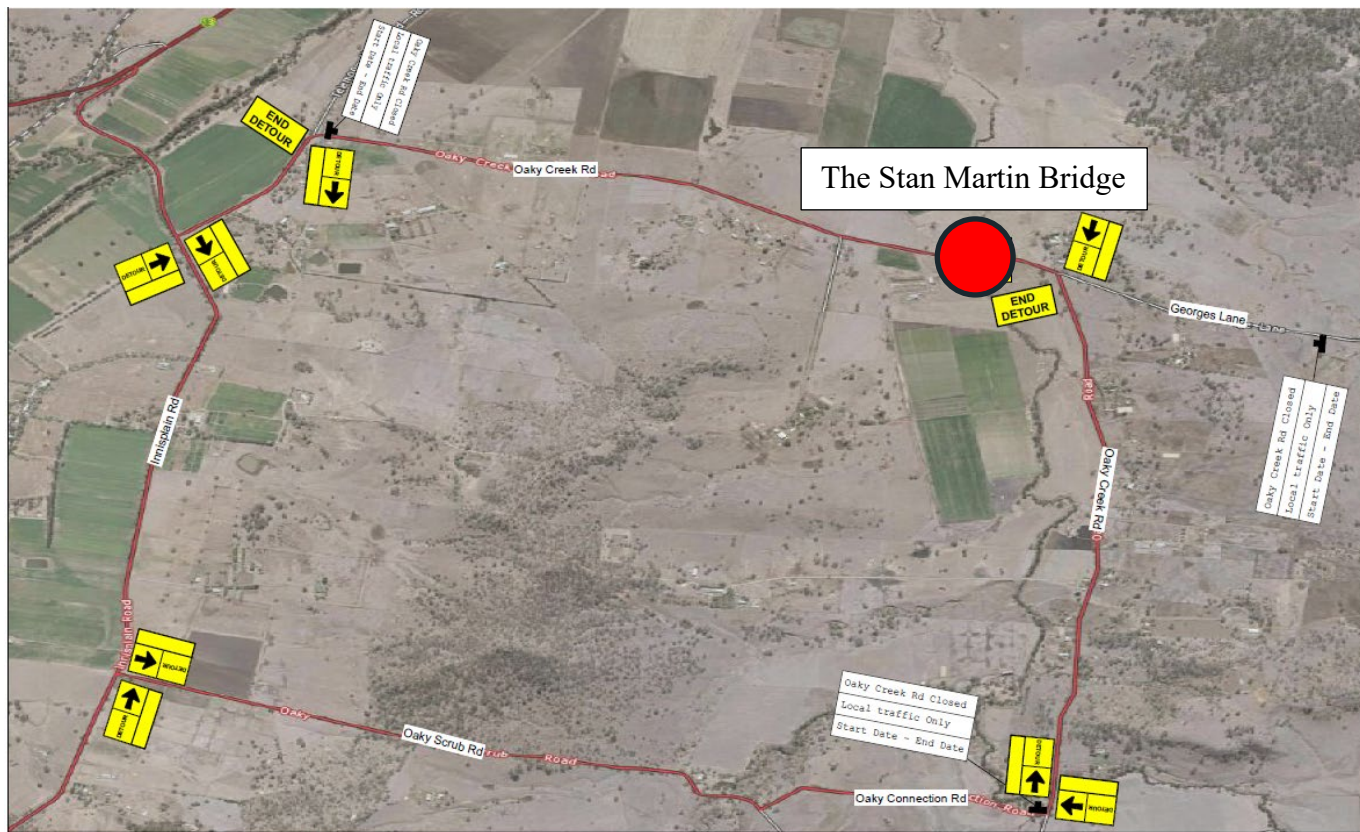
