

Benstead Bridge, Tramway Road, Tabooba

October - November 2022

Bridge Maintenance Works

Council will carry out component replacement works at Benstead Bridge. This will include selected girder replacement as well as replacing the existing deck with an improved timber deck.

Benstead Bridge will be temporarily closed for these works to occur.

WHEN WILL IT HAPPEN?

Works are scheduled to commence on 27 October 2022 and are expected to take up to 4 weeks to complete, weather and construction conditions permitting. Works will generally occur between 6.30am to 6.00pm Monday to Saturday.

WHERE WILL IT HAPPEN?

Works will occur at the Christmas Creek crossing along Tramway Road at Tabooba.

WHAT CAN I EXPECT?

To facilitate rehabilitation works, a temporary road closure of Tramway Road at Tabooba will be required for the duration of these works.

An alternative route will be in place via Christmas Creek Road and Rudd Lane.

Detour signs will be erected prior to works.

Construction plant will be active in the area during project construction, and there will be noise and vibration at the bridge site.

Council acknowledges there may be a level of inconvenience to residents, business owners, pedestrians and motorists while these works are being undertaken. Your patience and understanding is appreciated during this time whilst these works are undertaken.

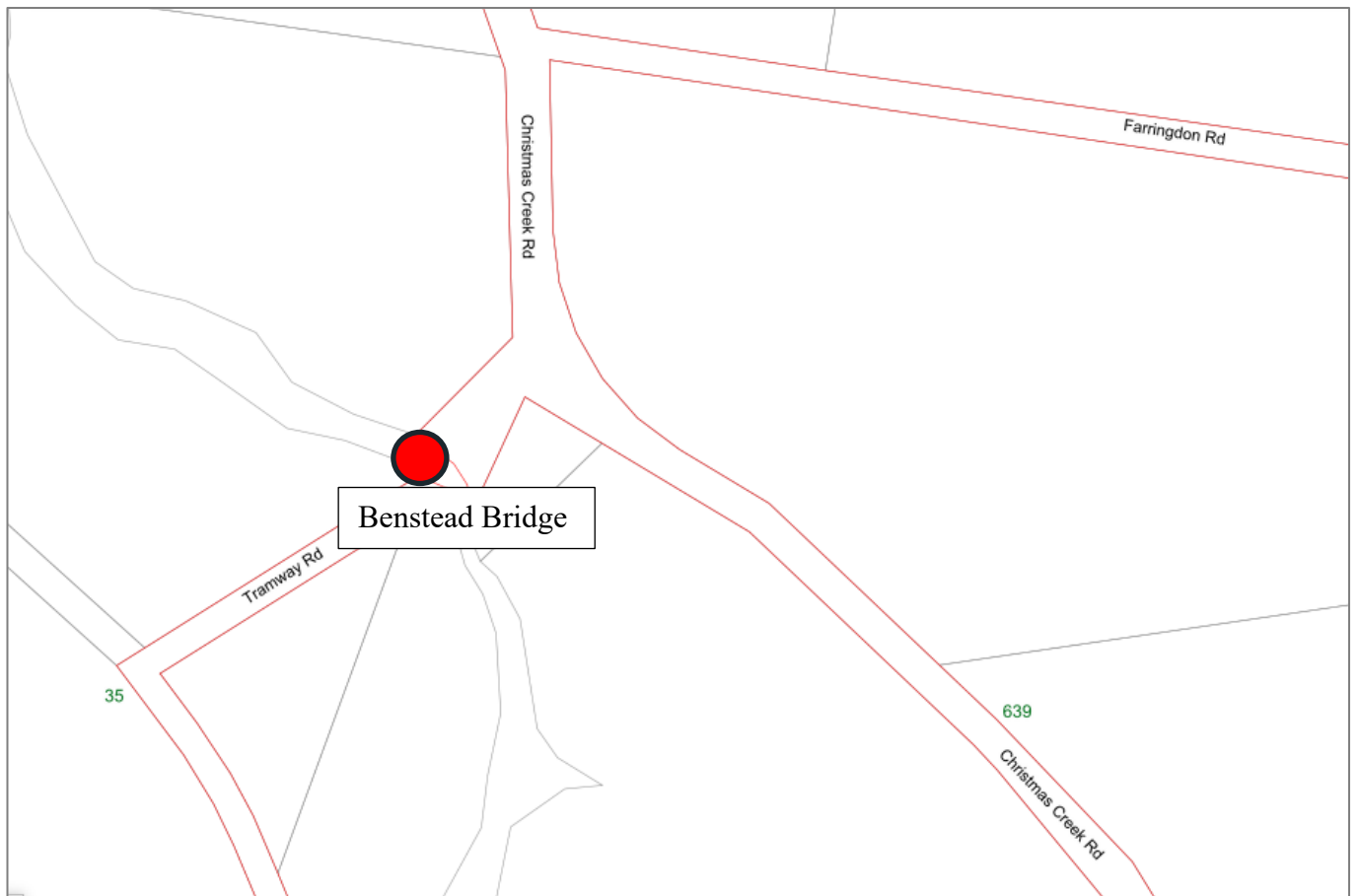


Image: Map showing the work site along Tramway Road (indicated by red circle).
