

# Footpath construction works

November 2022

## Alpine Terrace, Tamborine Mountain

As part of Council's ongoing commitment to delivering an accessible and serviced region, Council will be undertaking footpath construction works along Alpine Terrace, Tamborine Mountain,.

### When will it happen?

Works are scheduled to commence mid-November 2022 and are expected to take approximately eight weeks, weather and construction conditions permitting. Works will generally occur between 6.30am to 6.00pm Monday to Saturday.

### Where will it happen?

Works will take place along Alpine Terrace, from the intersection of White Road and Bartle Road, south to the existing footpath along Alpine Terrace.

### What can I expect?

The current access between White Road and Bartle Road and the existing footpath along Alpine Terrace will be closed to all pedestrian traffic to allow for construction to occur.

Temporary traffic management and partial closures may be required and detours will be sign posted. Access will be maintained to all properties. Construction plant will be active in the area during project construction, and there will be noise and vibration. Every effort has been made to keep disruption to a minimum to reduce the impact on the travelling public.

Your patience and understanding are appreciated as Council delivers this improvement to the footpath network..
