## Acacia Court to Beechmont Road, Beechmont

As part of Council's ongoing commitment to delivering an accessible and serviced region, Council will be undertaking footpath construction works, connecting Acacia Court to Beechmont Road, Beechmont.

## When will it happen?

Works are scheduled to commence early to mid-December 2022 and are expected to take approximately two weeks, weather and construction conditions permitting. Works will generally occur between 6.30 am to 6.00 pm Monday to Saturday.

## Where will it happen?

Works will take place between the cul-de-sac on Acacia Court through to Beechmont Road.

## What can I expect?

The current access between Acacia Court and Beechmont Road will be closed to all pedestrian traffic to allow for construction to occur.

Temporary traffic management and partial closure may be required and detours will be singed posted. Every effort has been made to keep disruption to a minimum to reduce the impact on the travelling public.
