

Tamborine Mountain Library Refurbishment

November 2022 - April 2023

As part of delivering vibrant and active towns and villages and Council's commitment to maintaining and improving the region's civil infrastructure, works have commenced on the refurbishment of the Tamborine Mountain Library.

The refurbishment will position the library as a vibrant community hub aiming to meet the needs of the community; offering a place to house library collections, meeting rooms, quiet study and maker areas, children and youth areas, technology hubs, complimentary internet provision, and gathering places.

WHEN WILL IT HAPPEN?

Works have commenced and are expected to take up to 5 months to complete, weather and construction conditions permitting. Planned hours of work are between 6.00am and 6.00pm, Monday to Friday, however may include Saturday works when particular construction activities are required.

WHERE WILL IT HAPPEN?

Works will occur at 30 Main Street, Tamborine Mountain (old IGA Building).

WHAT CAN I EXPECT?

- There will be minimal impact on traffic within the area as the majority of the work is happening inside the building, however, from time to time, noise may be heard from the site.
- A small section of the car parking inside the lot has been sectioned off for storage and there may be a reduced number of available parks as trade vehicles may temporarily use them.

Council acknowledges there may be a level of inconvenience to business owners, pedestrians and motorists while these works are being undertaken. Your patience and understanding is appreciated.
