

# Head Road, Carneys Creek

February - July 2023

## Guard Rail Replacement and Landslip Remediation, Head Road, Carneys Creek

Scenic Rim Regional Council has received assistance through the jointly funded Commonwealth-State Disaster Recovery Funding Arrangements to replace approximately 200 metres of guard rail damaged by bushfires, as well as landslip remediation and pavement repairs caused by heavy rainfall on a challenging and steep section of Head Road, near Brett Road at Carneys Creek.

Geotechnical surveys undertaken by Council indicate the foundation beneath the guard rail posts require stabilizing, meaning the highly weathered rock slope will be excavated and rebuilt, and a section of the road cut out to allow the guard rail foundations to be suitably rebuilt.

### WHEN WILL IT HAPPEN?

Works will commence in early February 2023 and are expected to take six (6) months to complete due to their complex nature, weather and conditions permitting.

### WHERE WILL IT HAPPEN?

Works will occur at Head Road, near Brett Road at Carneys Creek. Refer to map overview below.

### WHAT CAN I EXPECT?

Head Road at Carneys Creek is currently closed to traffic and will remain closed for safety reasons for these significant works to occur.

The most reliable, all-weather route is currently available via the Cunningham Highway (refer to map below). Alternative shorter routes are available in varying conditions for motorists but are subject to change due to current weather conditions. Council encourages the use of sealed roads.

Construction plant will be active in the area during construction and motorists should follow appropriate roadwork traffic signage.

Notifications advising of the works will be provided to emergency services and visitor information centres. The current Head Road closure will remain on the Queensland Traffic website at [qldtraffic.qld.gov.au](http://qldtraffic.qld.gov.au) as the official Queensland Government source for traffic and travel information.

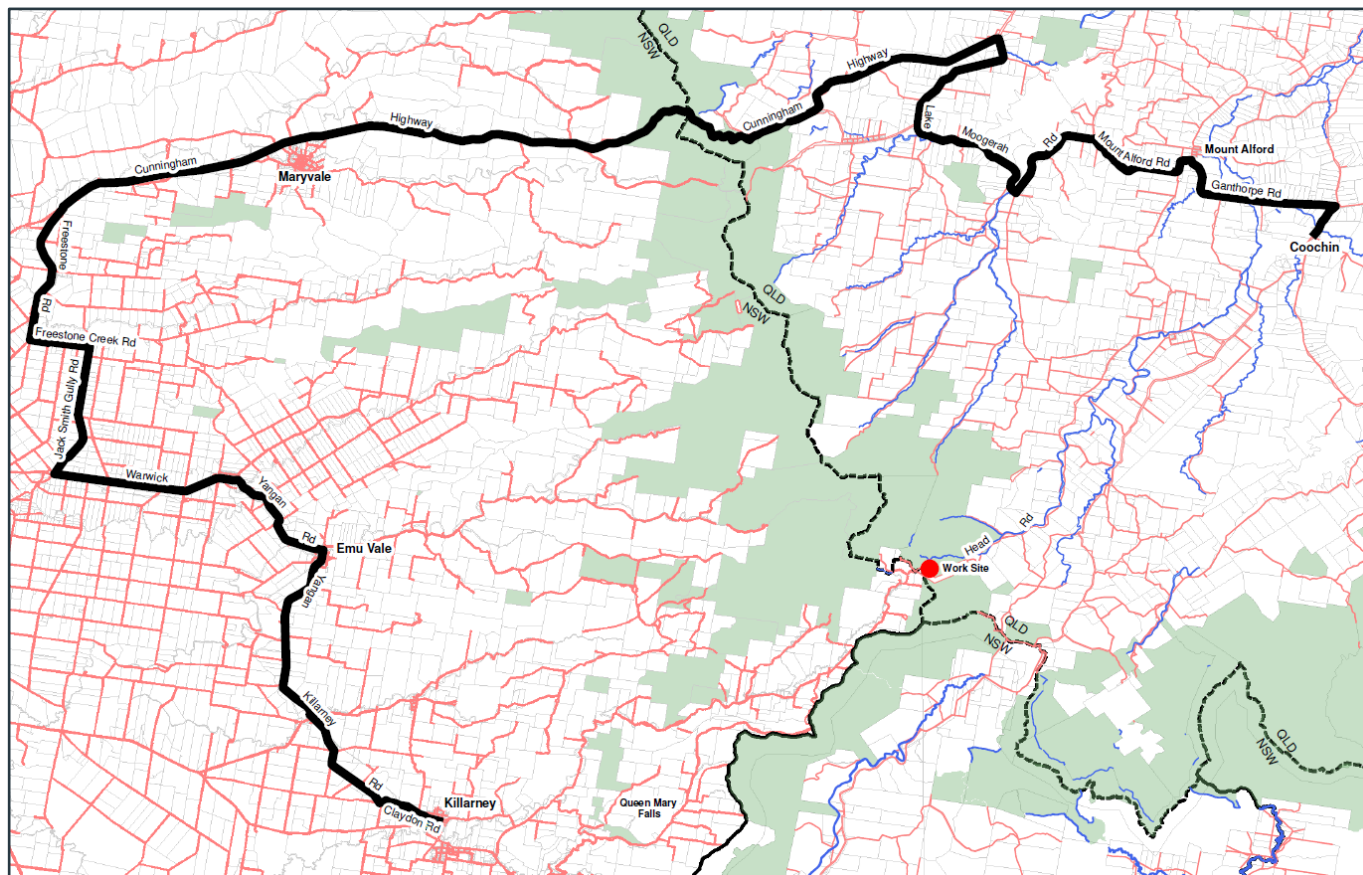
