PROMOTER

PROMOTION PERIOD

The "Bin Health Check" initiative (Promotion) commences 1 November 2023 and closes 31 December 2023 (Promotion Period)

HOW TO ENTER An Eligible Entrant will be automatically entered into the Promotion by the Promoter when bin health checks are carried out in respective areas.

WHO CAN ENTER

Eligible Entrants are the residents living in the residence randomly selected as part of the Bin Health Check Program, who's yellow-lid recycling bin shows little or no contamination and general waste bin shows no recyclable materials disposed (Successful Bin Check). The address will be used to differentiate each entry. No personal information will be collected at this time.

Participation in this program is not voluntary. The bins of all residents from the randomly selected areas will be checked and information will be recorded.

Employees of the Promoter and their immediate families who reside together in the same household, may be selected for the initial Bin Health Check however they will not be considered Eligible Entrants for the purposes of this competition.

CONDUCT OF THE PRIZE **DRAWNS**

The Promoter will conduct a random draw from the list of Eligible Entrants.

Each Eligible Entrant will only be entitled to one prize. If selected as part of the first prize draw they will be ineligible for any subsequent draws.

Winners will be contacted via a letter posted to the same address as the Eligible Entrant. The Eligible Entrant has until the date listed on the letter to contact the Promoter to arrange collection.

One week past the due date the Promoter will conduct another random draw of the remaining Eligible Entrants. A letter will be sent in the same manner as outlined above. These additional draws will be conducted until all prizes are collected.

- A Successful Bin Health Check requires the resident to do the following:
 - Present the general waste as well as recycling bins for collection on the scheduled day for the household.
 - When the presented bins are visually checked, promoter will record the address in the data collection tool.
 - The promoter will visually check contents of both general waste bin as well as recycling bin.
 - There shall be no resource loss (recyclable material) in the general waste bin presented.
 - There shall be no contamination (unacceptable material) in the recycling bin presented.
- 2. Immediate family means any of the following relationships between the employee and the individual: spouse, ex-spouse, de-facto spouse, child or stepchild (whether natural or by adoption), parent, stepparent, grandparent, step grandparent, uncle, aunt, niece, nephew, brother, sister, step brother, step sister or 1st cousin who resides at the same residence as a current employee of the Promoter.
