

Terms & Conditions

Winter Harvest Festival Tractor Pull Competition

PROMOTER Scenic Rim Regional Council (**Council**), ABN 45 596 234 931, of 82 Brisbane Street, Beaudesert, Queensland 4285

PROMOTION The Winter Harvest Festival & Tractor Pull Competition (**Promotion**) will comprise of two separate tractor pull events:

1. Senior Tractor Pull (Senior); and
2. Junior Tractor Pull (Junior).

PROMOTION PERIOD The Winter Harvest Festival & Tractor Pull Competition commences 1 December 2024 and closes 28 June 2025. The Competition will be held on 28 June 2025. (**Promotion Period**)

HOW TO ENTER An Eligible Entrant is a team of no more than 12 (Senior Team) or a team of 4 (Junior Team), with a valid registration form in order to participate in the Promotion by the Promoter.

To enter the Senior Tractor Pull competition, entrants must have celebrated their 16th birthday on or before the Promotion Period.

Each member of an Eligible Entrant will be required to complete a waiver form prior to competing in the event. For Eligible Entrants under the age of 18, a parent/guardian will be required to complete and sign a waiver form on their behalf.

WHO CAN ENTER To be eligible to enter:

Senior: To enter the Senior Tractor Pull competition, entrants must be over the age of 16.

Junior: To enter the Junior Tractor Pull competition, entrants must be between the ages of 10-15 on or before the Promotion Period.

All teams will be required to complete an event registration form as provided by the Promoter including a Team Name.

CONDUCT OF THE EVENT Senior Competition - An Eligible Entrant Senior Team to pull a 10-tonne Tractor over a designated 15 metre span as outlined on the day of the Promotion. (Pull)

Junior Competition - An Eligible Entrant Junior Teams to pull a 1-tonne tractor over a designated 15 metre span as outlined on the day of the Promotion. (Pull)

Each Senior and Junior team will be given two consecutive opportunities to complete their Pull and their fastest time will be recorded against their team's name.

At the conclusion of both the Senior and Junior competition the team with the fastest time will be deemed the winner.

Eligible Entrants must wear enclosed shoes. No spikes to be worn.

Each Eligible Team will only be entitled to win one prize. The prize money must be donated to a local SCENIC RIM community sporting club or organisation, nominated at the time of registration.

Winners will be notified on the day at the end of the competition.

	The prize money will then be transferred into the nominated charity bank once contact has been made by the promoter and the sponsor.

A release form will be provided should the Eligible Entrant consent to a photo. Unwillingness to participate in a photograph for publication does not exclude the entrant from winning the prize.</p>

Entry Information and Requirements:

Name and photograph of the Eligible Entrants may be used in advertising and promotional material by Council in any medium (including, but not limited to television, print, press, cinema, radio, email, website and social media) and by accepting the prize the Eligible Entrant consents to the above use.
2. Participation in the Promotion indicates acceptance of the Terms and Conditions governing the Promotion.
3. Entry to the Tractor Pull Competition is free. Entrants will need to pay entry into the Winter Harvest Festival to compete. Entry into the Winter Harvest Festival is \$15 online and \$20 at the gate for adults and children under the age of 12 are free.
4. The winner will be required to provide Council with their personal details (name and contact details). They may choose to participate in a photograph.
5. The Promoter reserves the right to refuse any property or entry into the Promotion at any time.
