Stormwater network upgrades

Works to improve the underground stormwater network on Brisbane are continuing and are expected to be completed by late March 2025.

These works will address the longstanding issue with flooding and the road substructure, delivering major drainage improvements which are vital to businesses in the Beaudesert town centre and the safety of the community during major rain events. *This project is jointly funded by the Australian Government's Local Roads and Community Infrastructure Program in association with Scenic Rim Regional Council.*

When will it happen?

Works are underway and are will generally occur between 6:00 am and 6:00 pm, Monday to Saturday, with the exception of proposed night works on both the northbound and southbound lanes to minimise disruptions during the day and impact to the public (weather and construction conditions permitting).

Where will it happen?

Works will continue on the Brisbane and Eaglesfield Street intersection and the western side of Brisbane Street (Davidson Park), up to the Selwyn Street Intersection. Please refer to the map to view the location of these works, additional parking options and street specific information on the next page.

What can I expect?

There will be a temporary road closure from Eaglesfield Street down to the William Street and Telmon Street intersection during the planned night works.

The northbound lanes of Brisbane Street from William Street and Telmon Street intersection and Short Street will remain closed until March 2025. Additional parking is available in Davis Street, identified on the map within this notification.

Short Street is scheduled to open to road users in mid to late December 2024 (weather and construction conditions permitting), to a left hand turn only from Short Street entering Brisbane Street.

Planned night works are in place to minimise the impact on local businesses. Please continue to support local businesses in Beaudesert during this time.

Detour routes and alternative access points will be made available and community are encouraged to follow posted detour signs and to plan travel routes accordingly.

Heavy vehicles are encouraged to use the bypass as the alternative route.

Residents and business owners will experience temporary road closures and traffic detours for the duration of the project as well as the restriction of pedestrian movements. Variable Message Boards (VMS) will remain in place throughout the area to help you navigate and stay informed during the ongoing construction works.

Residents and businesses can expect construction noise, vibration and temporary water supply interruptions and will receive notifications advising of the impacts once dates and time can be confirmed with the contractor and / or Urban Utilities, dependent on the works being undertaken.

Works on the western side of Brisbane Street (Davidson Park) are complete and will be open to the public mid November 2024. These improvements have transformed the area into a green community meeting place that incorporates a newly grassed amphitheatre and events stage, a multi-use space where people can meet, gather and celebrate.

Council acknowledges there will be inconvenience to local residents, business owners, pedestrians and motorists while these works are being undertaken. Please continue to support local business during these important works. Your patience and understanding is appreciated.
