

BRISBANE STREET CONSTRUCTION WORKS

Project Update February 2025



THE PROJECT

Scenic Rim Regional Council continues to deliver major drainage improvements to Beaudesert Town Centre with a number of key upgrades.

This project is jointly funded by the Australian Government's Local Roads and Community Infrastructure Program in association with Scenic Rim Regional Council.

- Upgrades to underground stormwater infrastructure in Brisbane and Eaglesfield (completed in December 2024).
- Safety improvements for pedestrians and motorists at various intersections, including Eaglesfield Street intersection (due to be completed in March 2025)

Council is delivering the final improvements to Brisbane Street which include the final seal of asphalt, footpath paving and landscaping. These enhancements are part of the ongoing beautification efforts designed to enhance the aesthetics of the town centre.

When complete the upgrade works will address the longstanding issues with flooding on Brisbane Street, delivering major drainage improvements which are vital to businesses in the Beaudesert Town Centre and the safety of the community during major rain events.

PROJECT UPDATE

The opening of Brisbane Street northbound lane remains on track and will be open to traffic by the end of March 2025, provided that there are no weather events.

During the construction works, contractors have experienced unforeseen site conditions, such as unexpected underground utilities which has impacted construction timelines. These discoveries have resulted in additional excavation and engineering adjustments.

Despite the project team's efforts to expedite the project by leveraging night works, a combination of these unforeseen site conditions and considerable rainfall during critical activities, and the necessity to prioritise safety in project planning has resulted in minor works falling into the month of April 2025.

Council apologises for the unforeseen delays in the project's progress and the inconvenience this has caused to road users, local businesses and residents living near the project.

WHAT ARE THE NEW MILESTONES?

- Installation of the bus shelter on Brisbane Street (southbound).
- New street seating along Brisbane Street (northbound and southbound).
- New pedestrian crossings will be open for use.
- Landscaping to Brisbane Street (southbound) to be completed by the end March.
- Brisbane Street Line marking to be completed in March.
- Footpath paving to Brisbane Street (southbound) will be completed in April.
- Brisbane Street (northbound) will reopen to traffic by end of March.

Council acknowledges there will be inconvenience to local residents, business owners, pedestrians and motorists while these works are being undertaken.

Please continue to support local business during these works.
