# **Beaudesert-Nerang Road, Wonglepong**

### Road rehabilitation works

**April 2025** 

#### **About the works**

The Department of Transport and Main Roads (TMR) will be improving safety by reshaping and sealing the unsealed gravel section of Beaudesert-Nerang Road between Mundoolun Connection Road in Wonglepong and Biddaddaba Road in Biddaddaba.

Works will start at the intersection with Elysian Fields equestrian facility, heading west towards Biddaddaba Road.

Construction works will commence from **mid April 2025** and take approximately six months to complete.

This \$5.2 million project is jointly funded by the Australian and Queensland governments as part of the Australian Government Road Safety Program.

#### Work details

#### Work hours will be Monday to Friday

- 6am to 6pm
- · Weekend or night works if required

#### Work activities include:

- · Pavement widening and sealing
- Safety improvements
- Tree clearing
- Line marking

### **Expected impacts**

#### Changed traffic conditions will include:

- Closure of the unsealed gravel section of Beaudesert-Nerang Road during roadworks from 14 April 2025.
- Access for residents in the roadwork zone will be maintained at all times.
- Road users will be required to detour around the roadworks (see map overleaf).
- The project team will make every effort to minimise impacts however heavy machinery will be in use and noise, dust, and vibration should be expected.
- Road users are encouraged to allow extra travel time.
- Advance warning signs will be in place and traffic controllers will direct traffic around the roadworks.
- Electronic message signs will advise motorists of upcoming detours, traffic changes and timing.

Wet weather, contractor availability and site conditions may change the work schedule.


