

Old Mount Alford Road, Dugandan

Road Reconstruction Works

As part of Council's ongoing commitment to delivering an accessible and serviced region, Council will be undertaking restoration works following disaster events on Old Mount Alford Road, Dugandan. This project is jointly funded by the Australian and Queensland governments under the Disaster Recovery Funding Arrangements.

The project will involve regrading and stabilisation of the existing road pavements. This will restore the road to pre-disaster condition in accordance with relevant standards and guidelines. Works will also include removal of a section of sealed pavement, and reinstatement with stabilised pavement to improve road safety.

When will it happen?

Works are scheduled to commence in late March 2026 and are expected to take up to 3 weeks to complete, weather and construction conditions permitting. Works will generally occur between 6.00am to 6.00pm Monday to Friday and may include Saturday works if required.

Where will it happen?

Works will occur along Old Mount Alford Road on the unsealed section and approximately 200 metres of the sealed section at the northern end.

What can I expect?

There will be changed traffic conditions with delays of up to 10 minutes. Old Mount Alford Road will be open under temporary traffic management during the works. Access will be maintained to all residents as directed by traffic controllers but there may be delays of up to 10 minutes.

Construction plant will be active in the area during project construction, and there will be noise and vibration at the sites.

Your patience and understanding are appreciated as Council delivers this improvement to the road network.
