

Moriarty Park Dog Park, Canungra

January 2026

Car Park Upgrade

As part of Council's ongoing commitment to delivering a safe and accessible region, Council is upgrading the car park adjacent to the Moriarty Park dog park in Canungra. This project is jointly funded by the Australian and Queensland governments under the Disaster Recovery Funding Arrangements.

These car park upgrade works will improve accessibility to the existing carpark and adjacent Moriarty Park facilities. The works will involve minor earthworks, pavement construction, and drainage improvements.

When will it happen?

Works are scheduled to commence late January 2026. Upgrade works are expected to take approximately 4 weeks to complete, weather and construction conditions permitting. Works will generally occur between 6.00am and 6.00pm, Monday to Friday, and may include Saturday works when particular activities are required.

Where will it happen?

Works will occur adjacent to the dog park, in the area of the existing car park, and will connect through to Coburg Road.

What can I expect?


The existing car park will be closed during construction, with temporary traffic management will be in place. Alternative parking for the dog park users will be made available north of the site, on Coburg Road adjacent to the sports field, and at the Canungra Pool.
