

Eaglesfield Street and Tina Street Intersection

April 2026

Intersection Upgrade Works

As part of Council's ongoing commitment to delivering a safe and accessible region the construction of a new roundabout is planned for the intersection of Eaglesfield Street and Tina Street, Beaudesert. The project will deliver an increase in pedestrian and motorist safety via the introduction of speed reduction features including multiple raised pedestrian crossings. This project is funded by the Australian Government as part of the Black Spot Program.

When will it happen?

Works are scheduled to commence in April 2026, weather and conditions permitting. Energex have already completed works to install a new power pole on Tina Street, and Urban Utilities will relocate a drinking water main under the intersection in April and May 2026. Council's roadworks to install the new roundabout and lay new pavement gravel and asphalt will take place in May and June 2026.

Works will generally occur between 6:00am and 6:00pm, Monday to Friday, with the exception of any sporadic night works that may be required to minimise interruptions during the day.

Where will it happen?

Works will occur at the intersection of Eaglesfield Street and Tina Street Beaudesert, and a short distance along each street.

What can I expect?

Residents and business owners will experience reduced speed limits approaching works and traffic control including stop-go signage at sometimes. Access to all properties will be maintained.

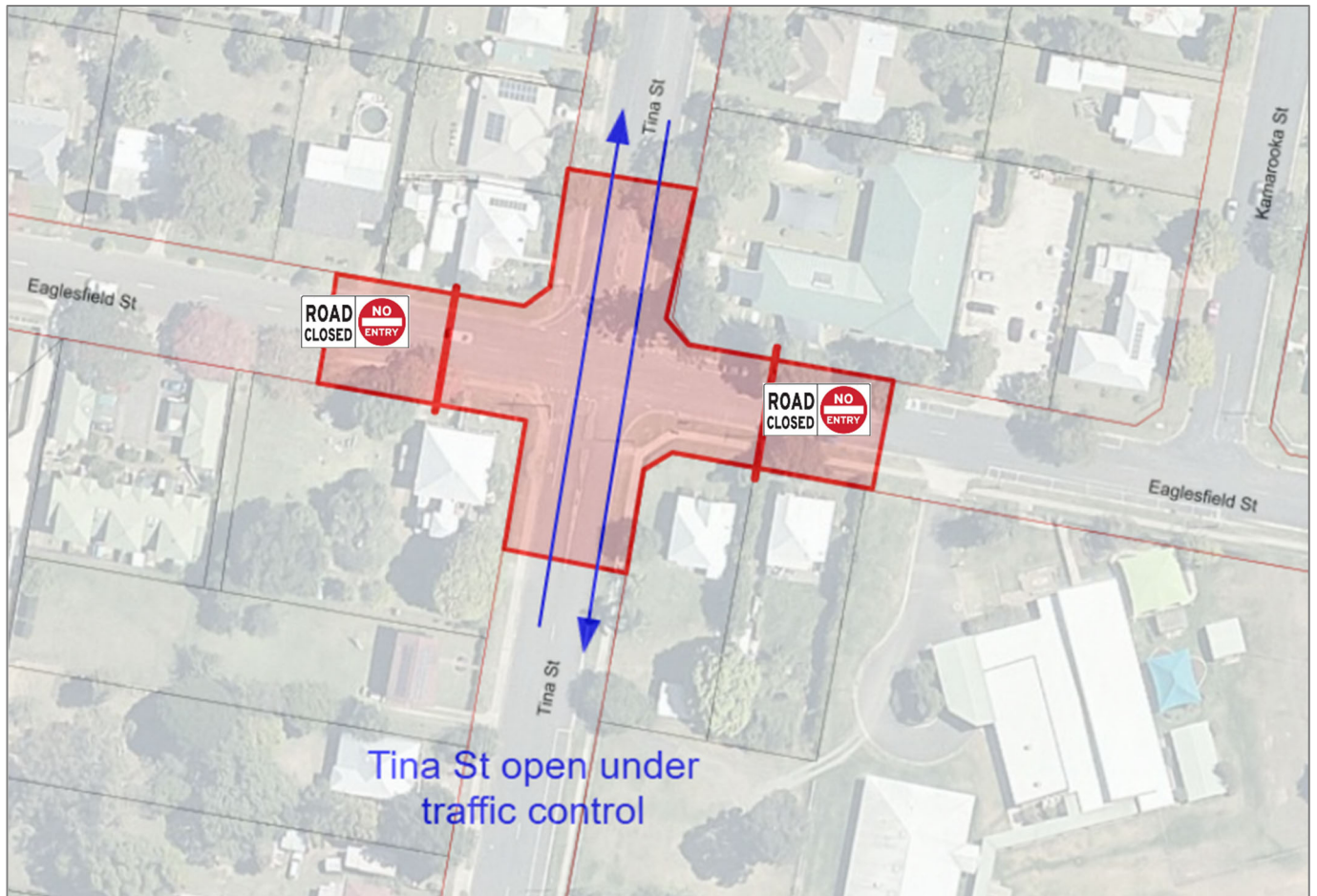
To enable road works to be completed safely, Eaglesfield Street will be closed near the intersection for a number of weeks. Tina Street will remain open under various traffic control arrangement to ensure safe access will be maintained to the Beaudesert Hospital, Queensland Ambulance Services and the Beaudesert State School and the large vehicles that service each of these locations.
