

Be Healthy and Active 2026 Expression of Interest

Partner with Scenic Rim Regional Council to build a healthier, more active community

Scenic Rim Regional Council invites Expressions of Interest from suitably qualified service providers to deliver activities as part of the **2026 Be Healthy & Active Program**.

The Be Healthy & Active program aims to improve the health, wellbeing and social connection of Scenic Rim residents by offering low-cost, inclusive activities suitable for all ages and abilities. Activities are delivered across public venues and outdoor spaces throughout the region to reduce barriers to participation and encourage an active lifestyle.

This program reflects Council's commitment to fostering a healthy, connected and resilient community.

Applications

Applications open:

9:00am Monday 9 March 2026

Applications close:

5:00pm Monday 6 April 2026

(Submission details will be published on the Council website closer to the opening date.)

Who can apply

Council welcomes applications from providers passionate about delivering affordable activities that encourage Scenic Rim residents to be healthy, active and socially connected.

To be eligible, activities must:

- Be delivered within the Scenic Rim region
- Take place between **1 July 2026 and 31 July 2027**
- Support physical activity, health, wellbeing or social connection outcomes
- Be affordable for participants (**\$10 or less per session**)
- Be delivered by providers who can meet the program requirements outlined below

Provider Requirements

Successful providers will be required to:

- Enter into a Service Agreement with Council
- Complete a provider induction
- Take participant bookings (if required) and respond to enquiries
- Ensure each participant completes a registration form at the start of each program block
- Submit end-of-block reporting, including registration forms and invoices, by agreed due dates
- Accept Council's payment terms and conditions
- Wear a Be Healthy & Active t-shirt and display Council signage at each activity (supplied by Council)
- Maintain and provide updated certifications and qualifications as required
- Book venues and arrange venue hire payments (Council will reimburse eligible costs once activities are delivered)
- Obtain Park bookings where activities are delivered in public open space
- Assist with promotion of activities through own communication channels where possible, using approved Council branding and wording

Mandatory Compliance

Providers must hold:

- Current Public Liability Insurance to a minimum of **\$20 million**
- Appropriate qualifications, certifications and professional experience, including **First Aid and CPR**

- Valid **Blue Cards** for all facilitators

If successful, providers will also be required to:

- Sign a Be Healthy & Active Service Agreement
- Complete a Risk Assessment Checklist for each activity

Funding Support

Council provides funding assistance to support the delivery of Be Healthy & Active activities:

- **\$60 per hour** standard service provider rate
- **Additional \$30 per session** for activities delivered in public spaces (parks or halls)
- **Additional \$50 per session** for activities offered free to participants
- Providers may charge participants **up to \$10 per session**, which is collected and retained by the provider

Providers must ensure the combined Council contribution and participant fees are sufficient to deliver activities for the agreed program duration.
