Project Update July 2026

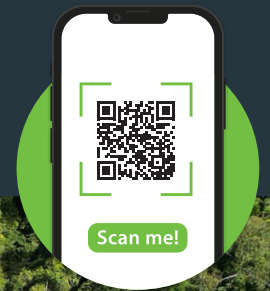


Image 1: The newly constructed road alignment

Scenic Rim Regional Council thanks members of the community for their patience while construction continues on The Shelf Road, Tamborine Mountain.

This project is jointly funded by the Australian and Queensland governments through the Disaster Recovery Funding Arrangements.

MILESTONES

Significant milestones have been achieved so far, including:

- Installation of kerb and channelling.
- Completion of the importation and placement of engineered fill.
- Shifting traffic onto the newly constructed road alignment, providing the construction team with safe access to the old road so works can continue works with minimal impact on the community.

EARTHWORKS

The construction team is continuing earthworks for the duration of the project. Construction plant - including excavators, trucks and compaction rollers will be active in the area. While there may be periods of noise, dust and vibration associated with these works, water trucks will be used to manage any dust emissions.

WHAT IS HAPPENING NEXT

Over the coming months, the construction team plans to:

- Commence demolition of the old road.
- Install guardrail along the new road alignment to enhance road safety for all motorists.
- Complete the installation of stormwater drainage as part of the upcoming works.

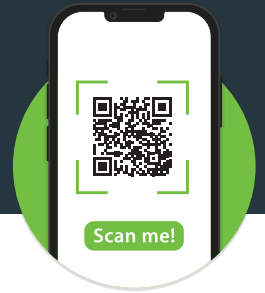
Residents and road users can continue to expect reduced speed limits and traffic delays along The Shelf Road as works progress.

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TIMEFRAMES

Due to prolonged periods of wet weather, the road construction project has experienced unavoidable delays. Since the commencement of works, the site has received more than 1.2 metres of rainfall, significantly impacting ground conditions and limiting access for heavy machinery, preventing activities such as earthworks and pavement installation from proceeding as planned.

These challenging conditions have made it difficult to progress the works. As a result, the project timeline has been revised, with completion now expected between September and October, 2026.
