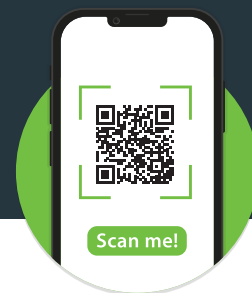


EAGLESFIELD STREET AND TINA STREET INTERSECTION

Project Update June 2026



As part of Council's ongoing commitment to delivering a safe and accessible region the construction of a new roundabout is planned for the intersection of Eaglesfield Street and Tina Street, Beaudesert.

This project is jointly funded by the Australian Government Black Spot Program in association with the Scenic Rim Regional Council.

ROAD CLOSURE - 30 JUNE TO SEPTEMBER 2026

To enable road works to be completed safely, Eaglesfield Street will be closed near the intersection from **30 June to September 2026**. Tina Street will remain open under various traffic control arrangements to ensure safe access will be maintained to the Beaudesert Hospital, Queensland Ambulance Services and the Beaudesert State School and the large vehicles that service each of these locations.

DETOURS IN PLACE

TRAFFIC

To help keep traffic flowing, traffic will be detoured via:

- Tubber Street, Beaudesert

We ask that motorists allow extra time to your journey and drive safe. Refer to map on Page 2 for more information.

PEDESTRIANS

Access to all footpaths will be maintained; however, pedestrian detours may be in place to ensure safe movement around the works. We ask that pedestrian adhere to follow the signage.

WHAT TO EXPECT

Residents and business owners will experience reduced speed limits approaching works and traffic control including stop-go signage. Access to all properties will be maintained.

Variable message signs will be installed to ensure the safety of both road users and construction personnel.

LATEST UPDATE

Energex has completed the installation of a new power pole on Tina Street, and Urban Utilities has now finalised their works in preparation for the upcoming road construction.

Road construction is scheduled to begin in June and is now expected to be completed by September, weather and site conditions permitting.

Due to recent wet weather, road construction works have been unable to commence as scheduled, resulting in delays to the program of works.

We apologise for any inconvenience this may cause and appreciate your support as we undertake these important works. Council is committed to keeping community up to date as this project progresses.

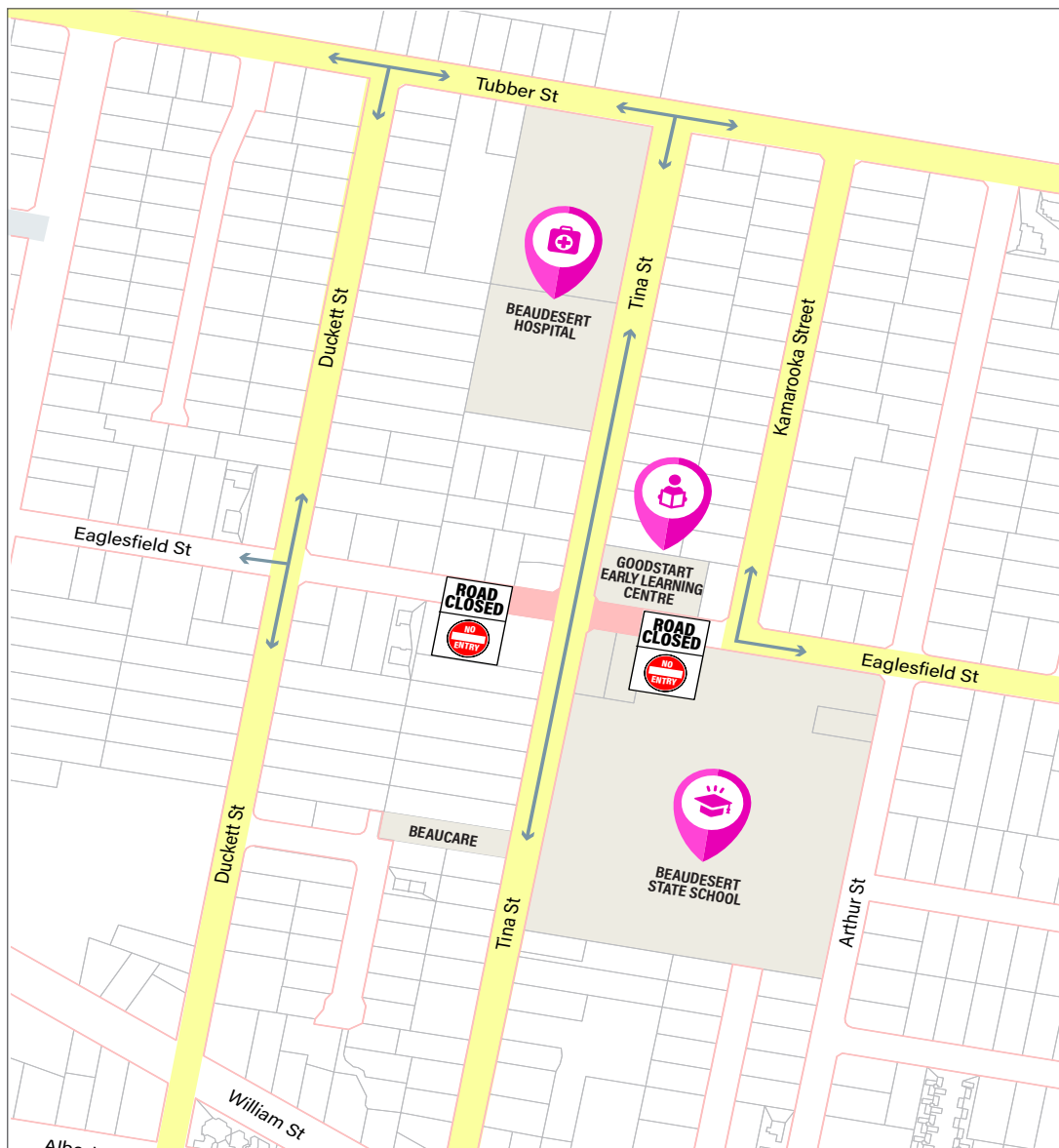
